General information on data processing:

A data collector collects personal data in accordance with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation (Official Journal of the European Union L 119/1) and the Act on Implementation of the General Data Protection Regulation (OG 42/2018).

The data controller collects and processes data provided by employees and business partners, solely on a lawful basis and exclusively for legal purposes, including:

- Data controller's legal obligation
- business agreement
- based on a data subject's consent

The official website [www: https://m-g.hr/](https://m-g.hr/) does not collect personal data and collected data are not used for marketing purposes.

Personal data will be erased after they are no longer necessary for their original purpose or in case of consent withdrawal and if the data controller does not have an obligation to keep the data stored.

Personal data can be exchanged with:

- Authorised internal or external data processors for permitted purposes and only in accordance with our instructions and with application of security measures.
- Courts, law enforcement agencies, regulatory bodies or attorneys, if legally permitted and required or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.
- With a data subject's consent

Rights of data subjects:

Pursuant to GDPR, data subjects' rights are as follows:

- **Transparency:** as a data subject you have the right to be provided with information on the purpose and lawful basis for data processing, recipients, forwarding to third countries, retention period and possibility of consent withdrawal, etc.;
- **Right of access and to be informed:** data subjects have the right to request the data controller to confirm whether his/her personal data are being processed and how;
- **Right to rectification:** as a data subject, you have the right to request your personal data to be rectified, amended or modified at any time;
- **Right to erasure ('to be forgotten')**: as a data subject you have the right to have your personal data erased by the data controller, if the data controller no longer needs the data for processing, if consent has been withdrawn, if their processing has been illegal, etc.;
- **Right to restrict processing:** as a data subject you have the right to completely or partly restrict the processing of your personal data;
- **Data portability:** as a data subject you have the right to receive personal data you have provided to a controller in a structured, commonly used and machine readable format. You also have the right to request that a controller transmits this data directly to another controller if they are processed automatically and based on consent or an agreement;
- **Right to object:** as a data subject you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data, except is processing is required for public purposes, related with the performance of official authorities of the data controller or legitimate interests of the data controller. If the data subject objects to processing, the data controller may no longer process the data subject's personal data, unless the data controller proves that his/her legitimate interests supersede the data subject's interests.
